Rules of the Student Grant Competition at the Faculty of Mechatronics, Informatics and Interdisciplinary Studies for 2019

- 1. These rules complement the Principles of the Student Grant Competition formulated by the relevant current Directive of the Rector of TUL.
- 2. The minimum annual total project cost is set at 200,000 CZK.
- 3. The applicants are recommended to discuss their plan (including financial issues) with respective the head of department or with the contact person on CxI (RNDr. Michal Řezanka, Ph.D.).
- 4. The overhead costs of the project are 25% of the total project cost.
- 5. The heads of the institutes of FM shall appoint SGS institute coordinators, who may also be coordinators of projects of the institutes. The coordinators organize regular seminars where the results of the projects taking place at the relevant institute are presented.
- 6. It is the responsibility of each investigator of an approved project to:
 - a. Present the results of the project at the SKFM held in the year of the project performance, and
 - b. Present the results at regular seminars of the relevant institute as required by the relevants institute's coordinator.
- 7. Publications supported through SGS 2019 must contain dedication phrase. For example: This work was supported by the Czech Science Foundation through Project No. xxx, and by the Student Grant Scheme 2019 project of the Technical University in Liberec.
- 8. In the event of a serious non-compliance with the rules and principles of the SGS projects, the Dean of FM may stop the project and allocate any unused resources to other ongoing projects at FM.
- 9. After completion and submission of the the final reports, the SGS FM Commission will allocate each project with one of the following marks: *fulfilled, fulfilled with reservations* or *not fulfilled*.
- 10. The Dean may impose fines on project investigators with a *not fulfilled* mark in the form of reduced scholarships or wage bonuses.
