ABOUT THE FACULTY

The Faculty of Mechatronics, Informatics and Interdisciplinary Studies was established in 1995 as a faculty focused mainly on fields combining technical disciplines (electronics, control, measuring) with informatics and natural sciences (mathematical modelling). Its original name was the Faculty of Mechatronics and Interdisciplinary Engineering Studies. Since 1. 10. 2008 the Faculty has changed the official name.

At present we provide education at all university levels – from Bachelor's to Doctorate – and the faculty has accreditation rights to perform habilitation procedures and procedures for the appointment of professors in the fields of Technical Cybernetics and Applied Sciences in Engineering. In addition to teaching, the faculty is heavily involved in science and research. The cornerstone of its internal structure are its institutes, which provide the scientific, research and educational activities. Currently, the faculty has approximately 150 employees and around 500–600 students study its fields.

The goal of the faculty is to offer advanced interdisciplinary studies to young people interested in technology, which lie on the boundary of classical disciplines, and those structure responds to developments in modern engineering, informatics and natural science technologies. The concept of mechatronics was established in 1969 in Japan, originally as a combination of the words mechanics and electronics in the field of digital control of electric drives of robots and machine tools. Currently controlled mechatronic systems are assigned with a certain intelligence (artificial, material) and maturity of structure.

Fully equipped modern laboratories and informatics resources are provided for course work and the faculty continues to invest in their development. From the first day of their studies, students have access to high-speed wired and wireless Internet and can make use



of the extensive services of the university library. This dynamically developing faculty offers a modern concept of education, which is often provided in collaboration with foreign universities. Ambitious students have the opportunity to obtain a dual degree diploma.

University graduates easily find work in industry, software and Al-oriented companies, and have the potential to compete internationally.

Now that you've been accepted as a Technical University in Liberec (TUL) student, you'll need to know a few things about studying in Czech republic and at TUL – before you leave home...

VISA INFORMATION

All students who need a visa for their study stay at TUL must receive an acceptance letter from the faculty. If the student has duly documented all the documents necessary for his / her admission, a decision on admission to the study is issued to him / her. It includes a field of study, start date, possible financing and more. If this is not the case, the student will receive a so-called pre-acceptance letter, where these facts will be stated and the date of enrollment in the study will be included.

All information is communicated to the applicant through the study department or the faculty coordinator for foreign students.

We recommend that you review the information about tourist and student visas on the ministry website.



Non-EU citizens who are applying for a visa for a stay of over 90 days should provide proof of medical travel insurance in the scope of comprehensive healthcare.

ACCOMMODATION

International students are guaranteed accommodation in the university's Halls of Residence and don't need to apply for any type of accommodation on their own. It is booked upon acceptance of the student at Harcov Residence Halls. The cost for students is 120 CZK/per day www.tul.cz/en/students/life-at-tul/ accommodation/ for a single bed in a double room. A small kitchen and a bathroom are shared for each unit of two or three double rooms. There is no need to send a special application form or to register. A deposit of 5,000 CZK is required at arrival in cash and in Czech crowns. The student should announce the date and time of arrival by e-mail and pay accommodation from the beginning of the semester even if he/she arrives later.

WHEN YOU LAND IN CZECH REPUBLIC You will probably land at Václav Havel Airport in Prague. Prague is the capital of the Czech Republic and the Vltava River flows through it. The so-called "Prague Hundred Towers" offers a number of historical monuments, such as the medieval astronomical clock, Charles Bridge, Old Town Square and many others.

1.309 million people live in Prague.

The city of Liberec, where you will travel, is located in the north of the country and is surrounded by the Jizera Mountains. It has about 103,000 inhabitants and is thus the fifth largest city in the Czech Republic. Valuable architectural monuments include the Liberec. City Hall, the Imperial Spa and the Wallenstein Houses. Although it is a developed and dynamic city with a developed industry and a population of one hundred thousand, Liberec lies on the edge of extensive forests and is literally a few steps from the center to nature. Perhaps that is why Liberec people have a bit of "Nordic" hobbies: they love mountains and mountain sports, for which the conditions around the city are ideal, especially in winter. Every year, tens of thousands of domestic and foreign visitors join the inhabitants of the city, many of whom have loved the city so much that they come to Liberec regularly. However, the city surprises them not only with pictures of mountain winter beauty, Liberec is increasingly sought after by lovers of summer sports, especially cycling, for which there are ideal conditions around the city.

CZECH CURRENCY IS THE CZECH CROWN (CZK OR KČ = KORUNA ČESKÁ)

The exchange office is available immediately upon your arrival at the airport. Located in Terminal 1 for arrivals. You can follow the current exchange rate of the Czech National Bank at www.cnb.cz. You will also find many exchange offices in Liberec upon your arrival. However, beware, some may have higher fees.

SIM CARD OPTIONS AT THE AIRPORT

It is also possible to set up a mobile sim card from the mobile operator Vodafone at the airport. There is also a slot machine for sim cards. All this in the arrival hall of Terminal 2. In the offer you will find ideal variants of prepaid SIM cards, which are suitable for short-term and long-term visits to the Czech Republic.

HOW TO GET TO TUL FROM VÁCLAV HAVEL AIRPORT

There is a bus number 100 from the airport to Zličín, from where you can continue by metro line B to the Černý Most station. In Černý Most head down, next to the platform number 6 to take a yellow bus RegioJet or it is also possible to use the services of Flixbus (green buses).

You can usually buy bus tickets conveniently from the driver, at a newsagent's or at a city transport company. Bus tickets from Prague – Černý Most to Liberec can also be purchased online on this website:

MEALS AND SHOPPING

Food for Thought or Thoughts on Food? Food for thought is provided in lectures, food for stomach elsewhere around the campus.

HOW TO ORDER YOUR MEAL IN THE CANTEEN?

Students must deposit money in their dining hall account using their ISIC or university ID card before ordering their first meal. This can be done in Harcov or in the Husova campus. The price of each meal is about EUR 1-3 and meals can be ordered up to one week in advance.






